The published data are for institutional units classified according to the REGULATION (EU) no 549/2013 of the European Parliament and the Council of 21 May 2013 on the European system of national and regional accounts in the European Union as public non-financial corporations in the subsector S.11001 and as public financial institutions (without a central bank) in sector S.12 Financial institutions (see list of public companies in the Czech Republic).

Data are not revised.

Methodological description:

The published data represent the stock of outstanding liabilities of public corporations at the end of the year as reported in the business accounts (in book value). Aggregate amount is comprised of debt liabilities according to ESA 2010 (AF.2, AF.3 and AF.4) above the threshold 0.01 % of GDP for each individual corporation. Liabilities of public corporations are further divided into the liabilities of companies involved in financial activities, defined through the classification of economic activities NACE under divisions: 64 - Financial service activities, except insurance and pension funding (here without a central bank), 65 - Insurance, reinsurance and pension funding, except compulsory social security and 66 - Activities auxiliary to financial services and insurance activities, and total liabilities of units involved in other activities according to NACE (non-financial corporations). Additionally, data for loss-making nonfinancial corporations are reported separately.

Data are published as a percentage of GDP at current prices.
