As a follow up, I would like to inform you that the Czech Republic wishes to introduce the temporary generalised reverse charge mechanism according to the Article 199c of the Council Directive 2006/112/EC as soon as possible. I am still convinced that the reverse charge mechanism is the most efficient tool to tackle the VAT carousel fraud in the EU toolkit.
